Falling plates – We have two sets of falling steel plates on the East 25-yard range. They are worn out. To be safe, they need to be flat, smooth, and angled forward. Ours are dish shape and pitted. The easy solution is just to remove them. The club is owned by members and that means all members are responsible for the liability presented by leaving steel up that is no longer safe to use. Replacing them has been discussed for a couple years. However, no one has stepped forward to work on that. Removing them will be on the next board agenda. I would much prefer to be discussing replacing them, but that depends on someone coming up with a plan.

We had a guy wearing a Sheriff's Dept tac vest on the East 25-yard range, standing on lane four, back about 10 yards, shooting diagonally off to his left at the plates on lane one. I am not sure how to explain why that would be bad. I don't mean it is bad to do this in uniform, I mean shooting.....

We also have had requests by members who wish to use their own steel targets. If you have thoughts on rules that might make these workable, please let me know.

Mark Richardson, the guy who supervises most of the range repairs, sent me pictures of paper targets fastened to the top of the target frames. That destroys the frame and costs work and club funds to repair. He also sent me pictures of rocks someone set on top of the wood target frame. Possibly, surely, no club member would be using rocks as targets??

We have a great place to shoot. Mark is always looking for help with range maintenance. It can pretty much be on your own schedule.

We are still looking for a contractor to replace the back deck on the main building. The rails and stairs are in rough shape.

The board voted to discontinue mailing paper newsletters starting with the July issue. This will allow us to publish the newsletter a bit closer to the first of the new month, making the information more current, and save the club close to \$2,500 a year in printing and distribution costs. Once again, it's time to COWBOY UP! 2024 Cowboy Action shooting season started on April 13. Shoots will be held on the second and fourth Saturdays of each month, April through October. Cowboy Action shooting is open to the public as well as club members though there is a \$5 charge for each contestant.

It consists of shooting with lever action rifles, single action handguns and either side by side double barrel shotguns (without ejectors) or Winchester model 1897 pump action shotguns. We will mainly be shooting at steel targets though we may occasionally shoot paper targets. Centerfire and rimfire rifles and pistols are acceptable. If you are short on having the proper equipment to start with, some members will be glad to loan you the proper equipment during the shoot.

The setup time is from 8am-9am. Shooting starts at 9am and is usually finished between 11am and noon. Remaining shooting dates for 2024 are 5/11 and 5/25, 6/8 and 6/22, 7/13 and 7/27, 8/10 and 8/24, 9/14 and 9/28, 10/12 and 10/26.
